#### UPDATE FROM RUSS AND ANNE



Daniel 12:3 states "Those who shall shine like the are wise brightness of the firmament, and those who turn many to righteousness like the stars forever and ever." Matthew5:14-16 states "You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in Heaven."

These verses remind us of one day in the ministry. It was a Saturday and we were doing an outreach at the headquarters for The Father's Heart and this girl walked up to us and we asked her if she needed prayer. After we prayed, we told her that the Lord brought her here for a reason and all she said was," I know. I saw this light over here and I didn't know what it was. But I just knew I had to to come. It was so bright, I had to come!"

To our knowledge we have not seen her again. But our prayer is that she realizes what God did that day, she remembers the message from His word, and if that seed has not been harvested yet that it would be so she might know what it is to shine for Him.

This is our prayer at The Father's Heart Ministry: that we would shine for Jesus Christ, and that the hurting, broken, and lost of the City of Rochester and the surrounding areas would see the Light of Christ through the ministry, lay down their burdens and chains, and call out in repentance to the One True God, Jesus Christ who can take away their sins.

The Father's Heart has been busy the past couple months and we can't believe that it is June already, and with that the warm weather has really arrived. It is time to put our hands to the plow even more.

We are still going out Thursday and Friday nights along with Saturday during the day and we are starting to add on a second outreach for some Saturdays for the bus. Every 2nd through 4th Thursday the Cadillac Hotel Outreach is still going on along with every 3rd Saturday the Pines of Perinton, with our big Family Day at The Pines of Perinton coming up on July 21st. In Rochester, we have to take full advantage of the good weather and get out there into the harvest while we can.

The Lord continues to provide for the ministry; just a few examples of His provision is Little Caesar's Pizza; soon after the article in the D&C came out Little Caesar's called us up and they have been donating anywhere from 20 to 30 large pizzas every Wednesday!!! (continued on page two)

When we were running low on meat, Seven Bridges Farm out in Lima contacted us and donated over 300 pounds of meat!! Or our weekly bread donation from "Frank the bread man" that always comes through and at times it seems that the Lord multiplies the bread.

All this makes us think of the Scripture Psalm 9:10, "And those who know Your name will put their trust in You; For You, Lord, have not forsaken those who seek you." That is our prayer at The Father's Heart, that this ministry would always seek the Lord in all things, that He would be our guide, our director, our head, and provider.

There have been many praise reports in the past few months at the ministry but there is one in particular that stands out.

We were at Jefferson and Champlain Street one Thursday night when a woman came up to the bus and wanted to give a praise report. She stated that her fiancé and her were at the bus last month and that they asked for prayer to be set free of their drug addictions; and the Lord faithfully answered that prayer and they were both completely set free from the drugs!!!

She looked like she was glowing and a new person but isn't that what the scripture says in 2 Cor. 5:17: "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new."

Our brothers and sisters over at the "Keys to the Kingdom" church located near Fulton and Emerson Streets are doing great! The pastor's wife called stating she wanted to let us know about the fruit that has taken place through the outreaches that we have been doing every fourth Saturday in their neighborhood.

From the outreaches there is a now a new family coming to the church that is going to be doing some of the worship, a new gentleman and a woman that was going to the church but wandered away and through prayer has come back.

This is just the fruit that the Lord has allowed for The Fathers Heart to see; we may never know until the Kingdom all that has happened through the ministry. We want to thank all the churches and individuals that have begun to come out with us on the ministry being His hands and feet and spreading the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

That is one of the biggest desires of the ministry, to see the body of Christ getting out there and being those evangelists and servants that we are all called to be, and we are seeing this happen and are so excited to see what the Lord has yet to come. We also want to thank everyone for their financial support and prayers for the ministry.
